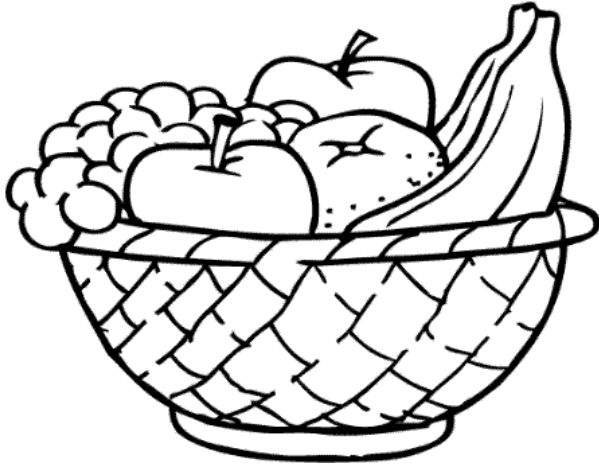

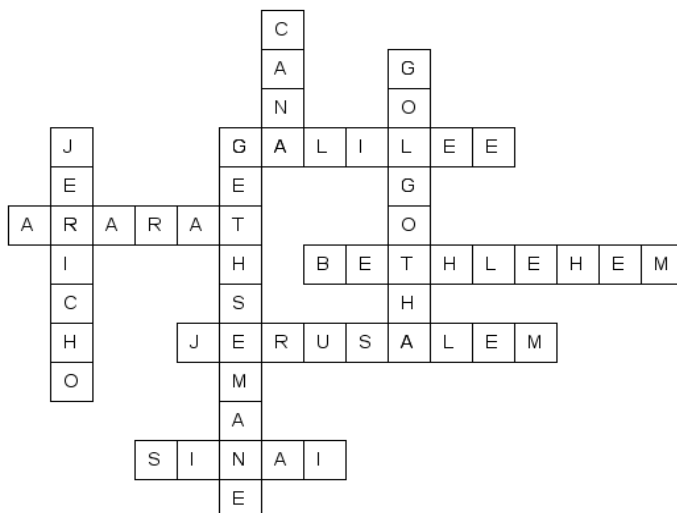

### The Feast of the Transfiguration of Christ

takes place this Friday in the Holy Orthodox Church

On this day, Christ revealed to the disciples His Divine Nature, though only so much as they could humanly bear. Only three of his disciples were chosen to accompany Him up the mountain, three of His closest and dearest: Peter, James, & John. This day is selected around the Orthodox world for the blessing of fruits, since it coincides with the season of the harvest. Symbolically, it is the significance of bearing the fruits of faith worthy of repentance and the worship of our God
