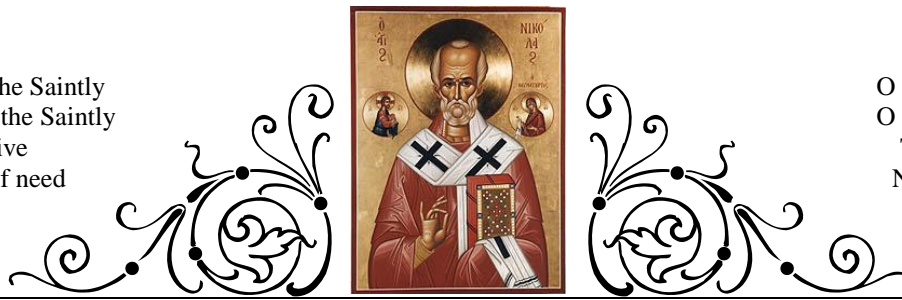

Today we commemorate the 14,000 Holy Innocents

When the time came for the Incarnation of the Son of God and His Birth, Magi in the East beheld a new star in the heavens, foretelling the Nativity of the King of the Jews. They journeyed to Jerusalem to worship the Child. Having beheld the divine Infant, they did not return to Jerusalem to Herod, as he had ordered them, because of God's warning in a dream. As St. Matthew recounts, "Then Herod, when he saw that he was deceived by the wise men, was exceedingly angry; and he sent forth and put to death all the male children who were in Bethlehem and in all its districts, from two years old and under, according to the time which he had determined from the wise men." (Matthew 2:16) Herod thought that the divine Infant, would be among the dead children. The infants thus became the first martyrs for Christ.
