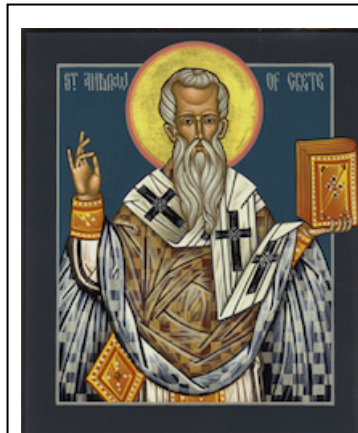

Saint Andrew, an Archbishop of Crete, was born in Damascus by Christian parents. By the age of fourteen, Andrew went to Jerusalem and was tonsured a monk in the Lavra (Monastery) of St. Sava. Early in his life, he surpassed many of the older monks and became an example.

After some time, the Patriarch took him as his secretary. When the Monothelite heresy rose – which claimed that the Lord Jesus did not possess a human will, but only a divine will – Andrew attended the Sixth Ecumenical Council (681 AD) in place of the Patriarch Theodore of Jerusalem. There, he displayed his gifts in speaking, his zeal for the faith, and his rare prudence. Later, he was elected and installed as the Archbishop of Crete, greatly loved by the people. Through his prayers he worked miracles and wrote a great number of books of instruction, hymns and canons. During the Great Fast, the Canon of St. Andrew of Crete is prescribed on certain days all around the Orthodox world. His outward appearance impacted those around him: “seeing his face and hearing his words flowing like honey, everyone found delight and mended their ways.” St. Andrew went to the Lord in 721 AD.
