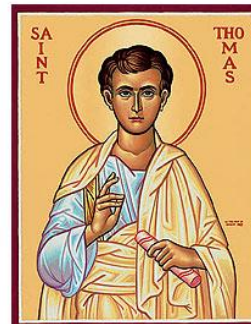

APOSTLE THOMAS



The Apostle Thomas is best known from the account in the Gospel of Saint John, where he questioned Christ's Resurrection when first told of it, followed by his confession of faith as both "My Lord and my

God" on seeing Jesus' wounded body. This was the reason is most famously known as "Doubting Thomas". Often maligned for this, in Orthodox teaching it is recognized that through his initial doubts, Thomas came to confess Christ as "Lord and God" – a greater confession of faith than any of the Apostles had previously uttered. In fact, "Thomas, being once weaker in faith than the other apostles," says St John Chrysostom, "toiled through the grace of God more bravely, more zealously and tirelessly than them all, so that he went preaching over nearly all the earth, not fearing to proclaim the Word of God to savage nations."

Tradition says that at the dispersal of the Apostles after Pentecost, St. Thomas was sent to evangelize the Parthians, Medes, and Persians; it is thought that he ultimately reached India, carrying the Faith to the Malabar Coast, which still has a large native population known as the "St. Thomas Christians" with over 3.5 million Oriental Orthodox Christians today.

Edward Kasinec will introduce the Czech ministerial official, translator of Ukrainian

literature and amateur photographer Rudolf Hůlka (1887–1961) and his only recently uncovered color and hand-colored photographic images that depict Sub-Carpathian Rus' in the early 1920s, capturing all the geographic regions, architecture, and peoples. The entire collection, preserved in the vaults of the Slavonic Library in Prague, includes more than 4,400 unique visual materials depicting Sub-Carpathian Rus', Slovakia, Moravia, Bohemia and, to a lesser extent, other parts of Europe and North Africa.

Edward Kasinec has served as a library curator at Harvard University, University of California, Berkeley, and for more than a quarter century at the Research Libraries, The New York Public Library. He is the author of many publications in the field of Russian and East European culture and has travelled, consulted and lectured throughout North America, Europe and Asia.
