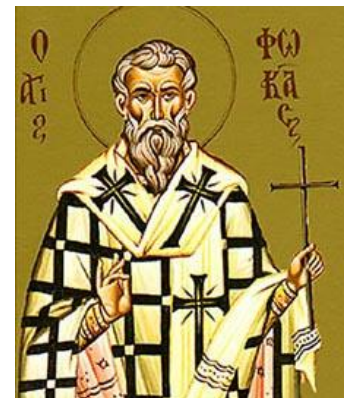

GREAT HIEROMARTYR PHOCAS BISHOP OF SINOPE



Hieromartyr Phocas was born in the city of Sinope. From youth he led a virtuous Christian life, and in his adult years he became Bishop of Sinope. He is known for his apostolic zeal as shepherd to the countless pagans he converted to faith in Christ. At the time of a persecution against Christians under the emperor Trajan (98-117), the governor demanded that the saint renounce Christ. After fierce torture they enclosed St Phocas in a hot bath, where he died a martyr's death in the year 117AD.

A homily in his honor was composed by Saint John Chrysostom when his relics were transferred to Constantinople in 404AD.
