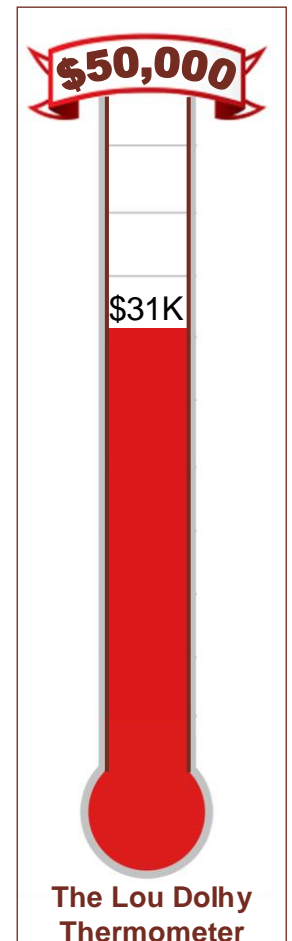

We will undertake the painting of the church walls, scheduled for mid September; this will be followed by the installation of new carpeting in the church proper, the altar area, the choir loft and the church entrance

In particular, we are “on borrowed time” with our main boiler and are investigating high efficiency, zone heating alternatives. Our ultimate goal is to leave our children without debt with the church building updated/upgraded to last another 100 years.
