We welcome Very Rev. Fr. Andrew Fetchina from St. John the Baptist Church in Rahway who will be serving liturgy today.



Those who are not fully prepared to receive the Holy Gifts, or those who are non-Orthodox, may approach the chalice to receive a blessing only. Please advise the priest or deacon of your intention.

GRAVE BLESSING TODAY: We will be leaving for Blessing of Graves **directly after** Liturgy in order to get to Mt. Olivet Cemetery before the Memorial Day parade starts on Grand Avenue in Queens.

The Savior did not send him there because of the clay, nor did the pool have healing power, but instead to test his faith and obedience.

SECOND PILGRIMAGE/OTPUST TO TAYLOR, PA


