SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 9th, 2025: PUBLICAN & THE PHARISEE

Epistle: 2 Timothy 3:10-15 Gospel: Luke 18:10-14 Troparia: p 48 (Tone 8), p 74 (Publican & Pharisee)

THE SUNDAY OF THE PUBLICAN & THE PHARISEE is the next important step on the way to Great Lent. In this Parable, as with many, Christ presents two figures: the Pharisee, who receives the best places at the feasts, presents himself at the front, proclaiming to God his fasting and his deeds; and the Publican, who says little and does little, instead repenting from a life of sin by simply beating his breast and crying out "Lord, be merciful to me, a sinner." Would that we were like the Publican in this moment, KNOWING that we are sinful and in need of God's mercy; instead, we compare ourselves to our brothers and sisters like the Pharisee did and think ourselves in greater esteem. In reflection of this: O Lord, save us!



The Board of Trustees and Officers of St. Nicholas of Myra Orthodox Church are submitting the following proposal for discussion at the annual meeting to be held on Sunday, February 9, 2025 February 23, 2025.

Proposal:

The Board, Officers and 100th Anniversary Committee have been preparing for our centennial celebration in November. At a recent meeting, a suggestion was made to clean the stain glass windows within the church proper. After considerable discussion, the board agreed to solicit quotes from companies who specifically perform church stain glass window repair, maintenance and restoration in the New York City vicinity. We received and evaluated several quotes before agreeing to present to the parish a proposal to clean and repair the 4 large stain glass windows and two smaller windows above the altar boy room and sacristy. The New Jersey based company who provided this proposal gave us a quote of \$13,159.

The Board and Officers are prepared to discuss this proposal in more detail and answer questions at the annual meeting. If the proposal proceeds to a parish vote and receives approval, the work would be completed prior to our 100th anniversary celebration.


