LENTEN BLACK & WHITE EDITION SUNDAY, MARCH 2nd, 2025: FORGIVENESS SUNDAY

Epistle: Romans 13:11-14:4 Gospel: Matthew 6:14-21 Troparia: p 43 (Tone 3), p 76-7 (Forgiveness)

FORGIVENESS SUNDAY marks the eve of our entrance into Great Lent itself. It also goes by another name: Cheesefare Sunday. This means for those following the fast, it is the last day of dairy. Either way you refer to it, it refers to the moment where we empty ourselves before God and one another. In the spirit of repentance, we use this time to dedicate special time for prayer in the fast, make plans to have your Confession heard.

HOLY COMMUNION will be distributed toward the end of Divine Liturgy for all repentant Orthodox Christian faithful who are prepared. *If you would like to make a bread offering for a Liturgy, please see Fr. William.*

THE VENERATION CROSS & BLESSED BREAD will be offered after Divine Liturgy for all faithful and visitors this morning. *May God grant you all many happy & blessed years!*

COFFEE HOUR will take place after Divine Liturgy. A special thank you to everyone who makes it possible to have coffee hour without fail, especially to our teams and Sunday regulars.

FORGIVENESS VESPERS will take place after coffee hour. Closing with the mutual exchange of forgiveness, this marks the beginning of Great Lent and our journey towards the Resurrection of our Lord. See you there!

A REMINDER THAT CONFESSIONS ARE AVAILABLE

Fr. William will be available for confessions before Liturgy on Sundays, before & after Lenten services, and by appointment during the week. Let us begin to shine in spirit once again, being made free of the weight and stain of our own faults! *"Lord, if you will, you can make me clean." (Lk 5:12)*

SUNDAY SCHOOL CLASSES: Dawn's Confession Class will meet as scheduled with student families; for pre-Confession children, there will be a brief lesson available downstairs on the stage with Stephanie, as she is able.

WEEKLY POST-CONFESSION SUNDAY SCHOOL CLASS @ 7 PM: Students will meet in the evening online with Fr. William for a 30-minute session with an activity and a lesson. Fr. William sent out an invitation to all parish families with students by email. If you did not receive that invitation, please contact Fr. William immediately.

DURING THE WEEK:

TUESDAY, MARCH 4th - GREAT COMPLINE & ST. ANDREW'S CANON @ 7 PM: As we take our plunge into the Great Fast, this special service is set aside for the days of the first week of Great Lent, among few others. It has considerable length, filled with many, many special verses and Psalms, and calls for frequent prostrations.

WEDNESDAY, MARCH 5th - PRE-SANCTIFIED LITURGY @ 7 PM w/ LITE MEAL: We do not perform Divine Liturgy during the weekdays of Great Lent, being dedicated to more solemn celebration. That said, still desiring to receive the Body & Blood of Christ, we distribute "pre-sanctified" Holy Communion. *Please fast from all food and drink before service, 3 hours or more. A common recommendation is from lunchtime onward, if able.

THURSDAY, MARCH 6th - ST. NICHOLAS BOARD MEETING @ 7 PM

FRIDAY, MARCH 7th - PARAKLIS TO THE MOTHER OF GOD @ 7 PM: This special service involves many deep prayers asking the Mother of God for her help & intercession, especially helpful as we prepare ourselves through the Great Fast and continue to ask for God's grace & mercy.

SATURDAY, MARCH 8th - DIVINE LITURGY @ 8 AM, ST. MARY'S CHURCH, NYC - GREAT VESPERS @ 6 PM

NEXT WEEK: MARCH 9th, 2025

ORTHODOXY SUNDAY PROCESSION will take place before Divine Liturgy. Parish children are asked to gather in the front pews to be carry either their own icons from home or icons from the church. 
